PUBLIC HEARING-PROPOSED RATE INCREASES FOR SEWER PROJECT FEES. PROPOSED FEES ARE: July 1, 2018--\$10.00; January 1, 2019--\$10.00 and July 1, 2019--\$5.00 (adjusting according to the Sewer Project Bond)

Dustin explained the reasons for the incremental increases. With new limits and regulation, we need to stop discharging into Cow Creek completely. The facilities plan will determine our cost. We should have several options, with doing nothing, to be one of them. Spoke about the Circuit Breaker Program; people who are on fixed or low incomes could be exempt from the increases. We could get a list from the courthouse. Our rates are already lower than most towns. We need to get information, as we get it, out to the community. We are putting information in all of our newsletters. As the facilities plan is developed, we will have meetings to inform the public and get their input as well.

Council will vote on this at the next City Council Meeting.
