CALL TO ORDER - The Genesee City Council met in regular session on September 16, 2014. Mayor Steve Odenborg called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL – Present at the meeting were council members Edie McLachlan, Art Lindquist, Ryan Banks, City Engineer Jack Hammond and City Clerk Karyn Wright.

VISITORS- Steve Ford and Laurie Ewing-Ford, Sandy~ Latah County Disaster Services, Mike Neelon~ LC Disaster Services, Debbie Montgomery, Warren Feigenbutz, Terry Feigenbutz, Erin Wittman .

Steve and Laurie spoke with Council about the proper steps needed to have water and sewer services to property they own on Maple Street.

Sandy introduced Mike Neelon as her replacement when she retires at the end of September. She suggests the City designate a "Hospitality Center", where people can meet family and friends, charge cell phones and grab a cup of coffee during a disaster.

Debbie Montgomery, Warren Feigenbutz, Terry Feigenbutz and Erin Wittman voiced their concerns on the Spruce Street site for the RV Dump Station. They are against this site due to the heavy traffic that it will cause and the possible odor.
