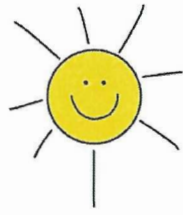

We will need even numbered addresses to water on even numbered calendar days and odd numbered houses on odd numbered days beginning June 1. To bolster conservation efforts, please only water when necessary. Finally, if at all possible, please try and restrict watering during the heat of the day and early evening. Thank You All For Helping Conserve Water!

The water tanks, located on Laurel Street, have been installed for anyone to use. This water is from Well #3 and high in Nitrates...NOT drinking water! Agricultural use only!
