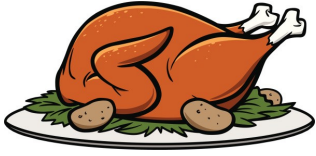

### ATTENTION GENESEE WATER USERS

- GENESEE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY IS SAFE TO DRINK
- On 10/5/21 WELL 3 (ELEVATED NITRATE WELL) WAS REMOVED FROM SERVICE LEAVING WELL 5 (MINIMAL NITRATE LEVEL WELL) TO EXCLUSIVELY SUPPLY WATER TO GENESEE.
- 10/7/21 NITRATE CONCENTRATION WAS TESTED IN SYSTEM AND WAS 2.53 mg/L.
- WELL 5 (MINIMAL NITRATE LEVEL WELL) WILL BE THE ONLY WELL PROVIDING WATER THROUGHOUT THE NON-IRRIGATING SEASON. WELL 5 WATER LEVEL & NITRATE LEVEL WILL BE MONITORED CLOSELY.
- POTABLE WATER STATION WAS TAKEN OUT OF SERVICE 10/12/21.

### PASTURE RENT



The City of Genesee is currently accepting written bids for rental of the city pasture located adjacent to the City lagoon. Rental period runs from January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022. Bids are due December 15, 2021.

The City reserves the right to cancel this rental agreement with a 30-day written notice at any time during the term of the agreement.

Rental payments are due and payable monthly. No statements will be sent by the city. Non-payment of the monthly rental will constitute termination of the agreement.

The successful bidder will be responsible for furnishing their own water and also upkeep of the fence surrounding the pasture. Upkeep of the pasture itself during the rental period is also required including removal of all manure on a regular basis. The successful bidder is also responsible for abatement of weeds, etc.



Please do not rake your leaves into the street!

Ordinance 350 prohibits accumulation of yard waste; branches, leaves, weeds, etc. Compost bins are available, 24/7, across from the lagoon on Morscheck Road.
