CITY OFFICIAL, COUNCIL AND STAFF REPORTS

Bill Krick- Water and Sewer Update and Well #8 Easement issues at wastewater facility with the access road. There is an agreement with the highway district that wasn't found previously. It was from 1934 and would be the best route to get into the new wastewater facility and hopefully everyone will be ok with that, and we may need to get an easement with the highway district, but it appears there was an agreement with PNW. The City would still have the ability to lock a gate at the entrance. The closing on the property is still on for the first of November. Bill took the city pickup to Wilson Auto in Lewiston. Seems the issue is the bottom half of the motor and recommended a possible rebuild on the engine. His estimate is 8K for remanufactured motor with a three year warranty. Dustin can explore some options on new and used pickups. Cody talked about the ARPA (American Rescue Act) money. John also asked about exploring a lease option.

Cody would like to look at our options, whether to buy, lease or repair. Government discounts might be worth looking into also. Council asked Dustin to move forward and let council know what he finds out.

Nyla Roach- Parks Update Jarrod Youmans is going to get started on the decommissioned Well House roof by mid-November.
