Ryan Rehder gave and overview and handout of what the wastewater project will look like. He said the design portion of the project is approximately 60% complete and the budget portion approximately 30% and he feels good about where we currently are.

GARFIELD LIFT STATION: Terrence discussed how this will be routed and all it entails. We are crossing Cow Creek Road in a good place.

BALLFIELD LIFT STATION: This is the current lift station and is being upgraded to take everything east of town. There will be a few modifications; concrete lids will be up from the ground and the generator will be moved away from the lift station for security.

WATER RESOURCE RECOVER FACILITY: There are six main components, that will be lined. Terrence explained the head works process of removing the solids out and how they will be disposed of.

DISENFECTION SYSTEM: Terrence explained how this process with flow back to Cow Creek in winter months and land apply other times.

OVERLAND FLOW SYSTEM: Terrence discussed this and said the city could put in a grass crop that can be watered through this system.

**WATER UPDATE:** Dig Well Idaho will hopefully be back in mid to end of November. The well house specs have also been approved.
