CALL TO ORDER - The Genesee City Council met November 16, 2021, Mayor, John Hermann, called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

CITIZEN COMMENTS: Jay Roach, as a member of P&Z looked up information regarding a pond being built on the Larsen property and it seems to be prohibited in our ordinances. Mayor Hermann thanked Jay for his comments.

SWEARING IN NEW COUNCIL MEMBER-Jesse Aherin --City Clerk, Karyn Wright, swore Jesse Aherin in as our newest city council member.

Back in Regular Session:

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

City Truck Purchase-Dustin emailed Mayor and Council the information on a 2022 Chevy Silverado 3500 from Dave Smith's Motors for approximately \$45K. It could take six months to get the truck. Council discussed and Cody feels there are a lot of positives. We need to decide if we want to open the budget and then use money we have already and when we reopen the budget, reimburse whatever department we use with ARPA funds. Publication in the paper and a public hearing would have to be done in order to open the budget. There were also discussions about additions we might want to put on the truck as well, so Dustin will try and have those numbers at the next council meeting. Motion made by Cody, seconded by Bill to approve the purchase of this new vehicle, using general funds that will be paid back at a later date; **ROLL CALL VOTE:** Krick, Aherin, Roach, Bailey; **Ayes, motion passes.**

NEW BUSINESS:

Well No. 8 engineering contract amendment no. 1- John let everyone know Ryan Rehder could be available by phone if we have any questions; Bill made a motion, seconded by Cody to approve Well No 8 engineering contract amendment no 1; **ROLL CALL VOTE: Krick, Aherin, Roach, Bailey; Ayes, motion passes.**

New maintenance employee-Motion made by Cody, seconded by Nyla to hire James Mader at the agreed upon rate and give \$1.00/hr increase with every license obtained, for a total of five. **ROLL CALL VOTE: Krick, Aherin, Roach, Bailey; Ayes, motion passes.**

Bill Krick- Water and Sewer Update and Well #8 Digwell Idaho is still planning to mobilize in November or early December. Mountain Waterworks is also working on the lift stations. Didn't get a chance to look at Jennifer's email regarding the lease agreement on the land purchase, but hope to discuss at our first December meeting.


Cody Bailey- Street Update Dustin and Drew have been doing some gravel work on Chestnut filling in a few holes and getting ready for snow
