6:00 PM

CALL TO ORDER - The Genesee City Council met June 21, 2022; Mayor John Hermann called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

ROLL CALL: Present at the meeting: Council Members Bill Krick, Nyla Roach, Jesse Aherin, Cody Bailey, Deputy City Clerk Debi Zenner and City Clerk Karyn Wright(Zoom)

VISITORS: Darin Henecke, Rick Schellenger, Nancy Feigenbutz, Travis Christenson, Linda Kiss(Zoom)

CITIZEN COMMENTS: Darin shared his concerns about vehicles speeding in/out of town on West Chestnut Street. The speed limit is 25 mph. He is concerned about children, and discussed speed data boxes that record vehicle speeds and what can be done after that. Mayor Hermann said he's gotten another complaint about speeding on Oak Street down by the Rec fields.

Well #8 Update- Ryan Rehder was unable to join us. Mayor Hermann said the Well drillers have sealed the test well and are back drilling below 400 feet on the new Well.

Mayor Update- Mayor Hermann read a thank you card from the Civic Association for help with Community Day. The cougar, that was in town, was taken care of Saturday. Fish & Game took the Cougar and is doing an investigation. No person or animals were harmed.

Bill Krick- Well drillers are past the problem area and back drilling. Within a month we should have more information on the Well.

Cody Bailey-The LHTAC Chestnut/Beech street construction crew has been fighting the rainy weather. They have been putting in catch basins. An update meeting is tomorrow and Dustin will attend and report back. Cody appreciates everyone's patience.

Jesse Aherin- no report

Nyla Roach- Concrete cracks under the picnic shelter have been sealed and today they've started the sidewalks between Walnut and Chestnut Streets on Laurel.


ROLL CALL VOTE: Krick, Roach, Aherin, Bailey; **AYES, motion passes**
