CALL TO ORDER - The Genesee City Council met August 9, 2022; Mayor John Hermann called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

ROLL CALL: Present at the meeting: Ryan Rehder, Mountain Waterworks; Council Members Bill Krick, Jesse Aherin, Cody Bailey and Deputy City Clerk Debi Zenner

Ryan Rehder, from Mountain Waterworks, brought a Power Point presentation he originally gave December, 2020, with updated slides. Ryan discussed the aging infrastructure and our future need of pressure booster stations for fire protection. Ryan talked about the cast iron pipes that should be replaced, even 100 fee per year, when there is money available. Fire flow is a concern in certain areas around town, such as East Genesee-Juliaetta Road. Fir Street was identified as needing a larger booster station. Different options were talked about, including a self-contained building. Fire hydrants around town were also discussed.


Ryan handed out cost sheets, so everyone would know the cost of replacing main lines and booster stations.
