Good news on our new well!!! The well drillers have completed their portion of the process which includes drilling 800 feet plus, lining and sealing the hole to secure the water down deep from mixing with any water that was encountered in shallower level on the way down. The other good news is that we have found what appears to be abundant water. We conducted a 24 hour test of pumping at 500 gallons per minute(GPM), which is 200 GPM more than our minimum needs. Currently we have a contractor on site that has started constructing the pump house that will have all the meters, monitoring and plumbing required to make the system function. Our schedule continues to be that this well will be online for us use by summer time, fingers crossed that everything continues to fall in place.

Water/Wastewater Update Meeting: Tuesday, February 14th, 6pm in the Fire Station

We are in the middle of open burning season which goes until the end of May. If you decide to burn, PLEASE remember a couple things. Open burning is allowed from 8AM to 4PM, unless there are winds predicted or an inversion which will both cause the smoke you create to go on to neighboring property causing issues with their air quality. The other thing to remember is that there needs to be a responsible person in attendance of the fire at all time with a pressurized hose for fire control. Yard waste IS ALLOWED to be burned, trees, branches, leaves etc., processed material such as lumber, roofing materials, tires, etc. are NOT ALLOWED to be burned at any time. Bulky waste is available on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays out by the lagoon for these materials.
